SUBJECT: City Commission and Advisory Committee Appointments

Collin Beggs, who has served on the Planning and Zoning Commission, has resigned. His term expires December 31, 2020. Included in the meeting packet, is an application from Jason Meyer, a resident within Sandpoint limits, who I have appointed to the Planning and Zoning Commission. If confirmed, Jason's term will become effective immediately and expire on December 31, 2020.

On the Parks and Recreation Commission, I have reappointed Joel Sargent and Karen Dignan to serve another term. Joel has served on the Commission since February 2012 and Karen has served on the Commission since March 2015. Also, included in the meeting packet, is an application from Amelia Boyd, a resident within Sandpoint limits. If confirmed, Amelia's term on the Parks and Recreation Commission will become effective immediately and expire on April 30, 2021.

Carol Deaner, who has served on the Arts Commission since October 2006, has resigned. Her term will expire March 31, 2020. Also, included in the packet, is an application from Barry Burgess, a resident within Sandpoint limits, whom I have appointed to serve on the Arts Commission. If confirmed, Barry's term will become effective immediately and will expire on March 31, 2020.

I have reappointed Molly O'Reilly to serve another term on the Pedestrian and Bicycle Advisory Committee. If confirmed, her term will expire April 2021.

Dear City of Sandpoint,

As a twenty year Sandpoint city resident, home-owner, small business owner and father of two children (7 and 10), I care deeply about Sandpoint and our future.

Among other things, I am concerned with the direction of future growth. It is important that we maintain the feeling of our neighborhoods. Yet we need to create good jobs for our children that are born and raised here. I hope my children and their generation will have high quality work options here in Sandpoint so that they may choose to live and raise families here. I believe families make up the fabric of our small town community. I think that good Planning can encourage smart growth that will allow Sandpoint to develop while keeping its small town charm.

Other issues that are important to me include outdoor recreation, affordable housing, protection of the environment and the lake, and clean air and water. I believe we should make efforts to keep Sandpoint's small-town, outdoor family identity and not risk losing that to becoming a playground for the ultra-rich part-timers.

As a small business owner I have been involved full time for 20 years in the construction-trade industry [Sandpoint Tile Company]. I regularly employ 5 full-time workers, and every year we complete dozens of new construction and remodel jobs throughout Sandpoint and the local area. I have employed dozens of workers over the years, and I am always concerned about workers being able to find long term affordable housing.

Three generations of the Meyer family currently live in the area including my children and both of my parents. My mother moved to the area in 1980, and I have spent a lot of time here between 1980 (I was 10 years old) and 1997 (when I moved here permanently) including summers and one year as a high school student at the Ninth Grade Center in 1984. I have a long history and understanding of this community- where it has been and where it is currently and where it may go.

As a father, a tradesman, an employer and a long-time city resident I care about Sandpoint's future. I intend to spend the rest of my life here and I hope my kids choose the same. For these reasons and more, I would like to serve on the Sandpoint Planning and Zoning Commission in guiding the direction of our wonderful N.Idaho mountain town. Thank you.
